Gathering Knowledge for Knowledge is termed as pure (basic) research



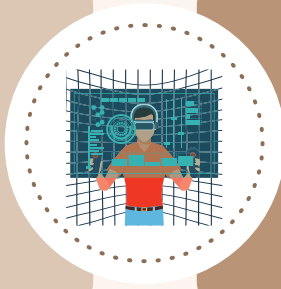
Research aims solve certain problem in the society is the applied research
